BLESSINGS FROM THE PASTOR

July 2022

Dear Friends,

I lament that the majority of my time as your pastor was during Covid. Thankfully, we weren't out of church long because we could worship safely in small numbers, but we were socially curtailed. One of my own lifelines was the online study group. Still not the same, but so much better than not being together at all.

Thankfully, many of us who had Covid lived to tell about it, but the church has not recovered. Experts say church attendance patterns are following the 30-40-30 hypothesis. Thirty percent of those members lost during the pandemic are gone for good. They aren't coming back. About 40 percent are marginally committed, attending with less frequency than before and less overall involvement in church life. The last 30 percent are the committed. They returned to church after lockdowns and remain as active as previously.

I don't have to tell you that's bad news. I'll leave that to the church treasurers, but as they struggle with less money in the plate, many of us are really struggling with less people in the pews. We miss familiar faces. We worry about the future of our churches and the future of church in general. We struggle with whether we should invest in growth or scale down. We argue about what needs to stay or change or come back. We wonder if we should walk away. Thirty percent of us already have.

I wish I had answers. I don't know what it takes to stay alive, let alone grow, but I know that God does. And I know that trials, in the church and in our lives, can actually strengthen us. They can teach us and lead us. The Apostle Paul says that perseverance produces character, and that character produces hope. "And hope does not disappoint, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us." (Rom 5:4)

Perseverance. Character. Hope. These three go a long way. I'm holding them close today, and I hope you are too as we pray for the church, the world, and one another.
