


Trinity will be collecting and bagging homemade cookies for Carlisle Truck Stop Ministry on Thanksgiving Sunday (November 26) after worship. We have experienced such fun in past years preparing the bags of cookies to be distributed to people visiting Carlisle truck stops in past years. We always have more than 100 bags of 6 cookies each to assist with the event.

Each year, between Thanksgiving and Christmas, Carlisle Truck Stop Ministry, Inc. conducts a cookie collection and distribution event. Individuals from local churches and other groups prepare homemade cookies and place 5-6 cookies in decorated bags along with a note, tract or Bible verse. These bags are dropped off at the trailer and then distributed to the local truck stops, trucking depots, restaurants, motels, and businesses to be handed out to drivers, employees and motel guests. Between 13,000 and 15,000 bags

of cookies are collected and distributed each year. The purpose is to let truckers and travelers know that we're thinking of them, that we are here for them, and to provide a 'taste of home' while they are on the road.
