Greetings, siblings in Christ

What a beautiful Spring is has been. Between the heat, the last day of the school year later this month, and the increasingly giddy anticipation of vacation plans, Summer's approach is in full swing! In May, it's like the energy level is turned up: Colors seem to brighten. Activities seem to multiply. Fresh air and time in the sun increases. Especially with children around, the excitement, tension, and joys of life heighten as summer comes into grasp.

At the same time, our Christianity can seem to fade into the background. Not only due to changing routines and priorities that often take our minds and bodies away from church, but also because the Christian stories we

traditionally tell in May are especially distant: May 9<sup>th</sup> is Ascension of the Lord day—the day we celebrate Jesus bodily *leaving earth* and ascending to heaven. May 19<sup>th</sup> is Pentecost—the day we celebrate the arrival of the Trinity's most intangible member, the Holy Spirit...

On the contrary! Acts 2 tells us the Holy Spirit suddenly fills the room with *a sound like the rush of a violent wind*, and that *tongues of fire* rested on <u>each</u> of them! Like the apostles, we are <u>individually</u> gifted—each in our own way—to share God's love with the world. When we use the Holy Spirit's gifts, and let her work God's will through us, there is no member of the Trinity we can feel more. So, let us move forward in this season with heightened joy, knowing that wherever the body of Christ goes, God's presence is still with us, and felt all the more in its sharing.






